

# Clifton pub supports worthy causes

Staff at a popular Clifton venue have been praised for supporting two worthwhile causes.

The Club Clifton bartenders Annatte Morris and Aiden Francis are taking part in the U.G.L.Y Bartender of the Year fundraiser, which this year runs from July 1 to September 11.

Each year, the Leukaemia Foundation helps more than 750 families from regional and rural Australia by providing free accommodation in our capital cities so they can access life-saving treatment at major hospitals.

The Foundation's apartments, town-houses and units are designed as a complete 'home-away-from-home'.

Funds raised by U.G.L.Y. Bartender of the Year provide this accommodation at no cost to families.

Since 2009 U.G.L.Y. Bartenders have raised over \$11.7 million providing over 145,000 nights of

accommodation.

Club bartender Annatte Morris said this is the second year the venue has taken part in the fundraiser.

"It is a great cause and we are proud to support it," Ms Morris said.

"Last year we raised just over \$300 and we have already passed that total, with still some time to go.

"I would like to thank everyone who has supported us thus far.

"A special thanks must go out to our biggest supporter Charlie May."

Locals are able to support the 'U.G.L.Y Bartenders' by dropping money into the cash tins, buying \$2 raffle tickets with some great prizes up for grabs or by balancing a coin on top of a lemon floating in water.

As well as the U.G.L.Y Bartender fundraiser, The Club Clifton also took part in

the 'Parma For A Farmer.'

'Parma For A Farmer,' is a fundraising initiative that sees hotels, clubs, restaurants, eateries across Australia agree to give an amount from every 'parmy,' sold to the Buy a Bale campaign.

The Club was able to raise \$200 for the Buy a Bale campaign.

"We sold a lot of 'parmys,' during our fundraiser," Ms Morris said.
